N4C POINT SCHEDULE FOR HONORS

Associateship and Fellowship of N4C honor outstanding members who have distinguished themselves both photographically and by service to the Council and its member clubs. These honors have been designed not only to reward the deserving, but also to stimulate the creative photographic efforts of all Council members and to encourage cooperation and assistance between the more experienced members and the beginners. The requirements listed below have been balanced so that either an outstanding photographer or a very active club worker can achieve an Associateship, but to attain a Fellowship, a candidate must be both a top photographer and a willing, helpful worker at his/her club and the council.

1. The Honors Committee is composed of the Council Vice-President as Chairman, the Council President, and the Presidents or their appointed representatives of five member clubs. The five clubs are selected alphabetically from the current N4C Roster. No member of the Committee shall serve more than two consecutive years. This Committee meets at least once a year to act on any honor applications received. The Honors Committee shall contact those applicants found to be ineligible. Suitable inscribed honors certificates are presented at N4C's Annual Banquet. Recipients of the honors will be listed in FotoFanFare and added to the N4C Honors list.
2. A formal application must be submitted. It will contain detailed evidence such as specific dates and references substantiating all claims. Each claim for credit points must be identified with the corresponding activity letter. The application, whether initiated by the applicant or by a sponsor, must have the signed approval of an officer from the applicant's camera club.
3. Associateship and Fellowship honors are granted on the basis of accumulated points. The Associateship requires at least 50 points; the Fellowship 100 points. An applicant must have been a member of an N4C club for at least three years before becoming eligible for an Associateship. A Fellowship may only be awarded to a person who has held an Associateship for at least one year.
4. The Council, by resolution, may bestow upon deserving individuals, who are not members of the Council, the Honorary (N4C) honor in recognition of outstanding service or achievement.
5. Points earned for the Associateship are accumulated and applied to the Fellowship. When applying for the Fellowship ALL points, including the points earned for the Associateship must be listed on the application. All associateship members desiring the Fellowship are reminded that they must make separate application for the Fellowship regardless of the number of points itemized in their original application for Associateship.

ACTIVITY LETTER

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY

MEMBER CLUB POINTS

- A. Hold an elective office in a member club for a full term. President, 5 points; other elected office, 3 points. (Maximum: 10 points)
- B. Hold an appointive committee chairmanship in a member club, 3 points; member of a permanent club committee, 1 point. (Maximum: 10 points)
- C. Top point scorer in member club for any year(s), 5 points per division. (Maximum: 10 points)

N4C POINTS

- D. Be a Council delegate for one full year, 2 points. (Maximum: 10 points.)
- E. Place in Monthly Council interclub competition: 1st place, 5 points; 2nd place, 4 points; 3rd place, 3 points; 4th place, 2 points; 5th place, 1 point; HM, ½ point. (A total of 30 points may be claimed in this activity. Example: if 20 points were claimed for an Associateship, only 10 more points may be claimed toward the Fellowship.)
- F. Hold an elective office in the Council for a full term, 5 points. Hold a chairmanship for a full term, 5 points. Members of a Council committee for a full term, 3 points. Maximum: 10 points. (An additional 5 points may be claimed when applying for a Fellowship.)
- G. Hold a chairmanship in FotoClave for a full term, 5 points. Members of a FotoClave committee for a full term, 3 points. Maximum: 10 points. (An additional 5 points may be claimed when applying for a Fellowship.)
- H. Editor of FotoFanFare, 5 points. Maximum: 10 points. (An additional 5 points may be claimed when applying for a Fellowship.)
- I. Members of special Council committees who serve less than one year, 1 point. (Maximum: 10 points) Activities to be verified from Council minutes or FotoFanFare.
- J. Perform special service(s) to the Council (exclusive from other points claimed) over a period of years. This activity must be specifically voted on by the Honors Committee and it must be documented in detail, up to 10 points may be awarded. (Maximum: 10 points) (An Additional 5 points may be claimed for Fellowship)
- K. Acceptances in FotoClave, 1 point per acceptance. (Maximum: 10 points)

THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT RECEIVES AN HONORARY N4C HONOR AT THE END OF HIS/HER TERM. (Not applicable for points.)

OTHER POINTS

- L. Judge camera club competition at club not his/her own, 1 point per judging. (Maximum points: 10) (Additional 5 points may be claimed for Fellowship.)
- M. Judge N4C Interclub Competition, 1 point per judging. (Maximum: 10 points) (Additional 5 points may be claimed for Fellowship.)
- N. Judge at camera club or council outside N4C, 1 point per judging. (Maximum: 10 points) (Additional 5 points may be claimed when applying for Fellowship.)
- O. Judge at international photographic exhibitions, or at fairs: 2 points. (Maximum: 10 points) (An additional 5 points may be claimed when applying for Fellowship.)
- P. Present an instructional program to member club not his/her own, 5 points per program. (Maximum: 10 points) (Additional 5 points may be claimed for Fellowship.)
- Q. Acceptances in international photographic exhibitions, 1 point for five (5) acceptances. (Maximum: 10 points)
- R. Judge an individual or club competition through the Photographic Society of America, 2 points per judging. (Maximum: 10 points)
- S. Perform special services to a member club or the photo activity of a civic organization, such as the Boy Scouts, over a period of years. This activity must receive a special vote by the Honors Committee and must be documented by a letter signed by at least three officers of the organization where the service was performed. (Maximum: 10 points)
